'KEEPER OF THE SEVEN KEYS - THE LEGACY - WORLD TOUR 2005/2006' DOUBLE 'LIVE IN SAO PAULO' CD & 'LIVE ON 3 CONTINENTS' DOUBLE DVD RELEASED ON SPV FEBRUARY 26TH

German Power Metal innovators Helloween are set to release their double live CD 'Keeper Of The Seven Keys - The Legacy - World Tour 2005/2006 Live In Sao Paulo' and double live 'Keeper Of The Seven Keys - The Legacy - World Tour 2005/2006 Live On 3 Continents' DVD on SPV (via RSK) on February 26th.

Following the critically acclaimed 2005 release of Helloween's 'Keeper Of The Seven Keys – The Legacy' studio album, the band set off on a world tour taking in over 100 concerts in 40 countries, playing packed venues wherever they appeared.

Helloween filmed and recorded three sensational shows - in Sofia, Tokyo and Sao Paulo – where the band are captured in their full glory playing many tracks from 'Keeper Of The Seven Keys – The Legacy', as well as a host of classic songs from across their long and illustrious twenty-plus-year long career. Over 6,000 enthusiastic fans came to the Sao Paolo gig on March 25th 2006, where the majority of the cuts were recorded, celebrating their idols with frenetic applause.

'Keeper Of The Seven Keys – The Legacy World Tour 2005/2006 Live On 3 Continents / Live In Sao Paulo' is scheduled to be released 1) as a double DVD plus double CD in a limited edition, featuring a top-quality Digipak with slipcase, 2) as a softbox double DVD; and 3) as a regular jewel case double CD.

The film footage comes on a DVD 9 featuring PAL and NTSC versions, in audio formats Dolby Digital 2.0 and Dolby Digital 5.1. Some tracks feature a special multi-media tool which allows the viewer to switch between the different shows. DVD 1 contains over 1 hour and 50 minutes of live footage from Sao Paolo. DVD 2 features 'Occasion Avenue' filmed in Tokyo and ''Halloween', filmed at the Masters Of Rock Festival in Vizovice, Czech Republic alongside a 47-minute road movie, plus 44 minutes of interviews with the musicians, and the official 'Mrs. God' and 'Light The Universe' video clips.

The double CD has an overall playing time of almost two hours, including the entire Sao Paolo concert, plus two bonus tracks 'Occasion Avenue' recorded in Tokyo and 'Halloween' recorded at the Masters Of Rock Festival in Vizovice, Czech Republic. The tracks were mixed by longstanding Helloween producer Charlie Bauerfeind.
